The Winter Concert is Tuesday, December 12th at 7:00pm in the BRHS PAC. The dress rehearsal is **mandatory** for all students in order to participate in the concert. In an effort to accommodate everyone's busy schedules, we are maintaining two concerts in one evening. To ensure orderly proceedings <u>concert times</u> are <u>listed</u> as <u>follows</u>:

Intermission: Stage setup. Chorus parents seated. Instrumental parents dismissed.

8:00: Chorus performance

Instrumental students will be reporting to the music rooms on the lower level of BRHS. Chorus students will be reporting to the three classrooms opposite the music rooms. These rooms will be marked with homeroom teachers' names.

<u>Concert Attire</u>: Students are to wear white shirts or blouses, black dress slacks or skirts, and dark comfortable shoes. They do not need to wear this at the in-school rehearsals.

We are attempting to eliminate movement during the performance to teach proper concert etiquette. If the instrumental portion is still ongoing when you arrive, please do not interrupt the performance. We will permit chorus parents to be seated after the instrumental parents have exited the auditorium. Intermission will allow enough time for instrumental parents to leave, choral parents to be seated, and the stage to be set up for the chorus performance.

It has been requested by BPAC personnel that strollers be eliminated or left in the main office. There is absolutely **no food or drink** allowed in the BPAC.
